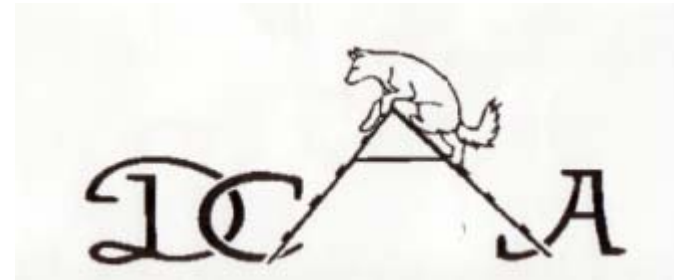

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES will not be accepted. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Unsigned entries or entries missing information other than the dog’s call name will be returned. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. **Entry Fees: \$23 first class / \$13 for 2nd class and / \$13 for a 3rd class, same dog, same day (includes \$3.00 Per Run AKC recording fee).** Make checks payable to ‘Derby City Agility Assoc.’ or ‘DCAA’. Checks must be payable in U.S. Funds. **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.** Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary’s address without recipient’s signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible or having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

All dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the AKC, or that have a Limited Registration, ILP or PAL, are eligible to enter this trial. **DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.**

Classes Offered:

ALL THREE DAYS: Novice A & B, Open and Excellent A & B Standard & Jumpers w/Weaves classes in Regular and Novice, Open and Excellent A & B Standard & Jumpers w/Weaves classes in Preferred.

Saturday & Sunday ONLY Novice A & B, Open and Excellent A & B in Regular FAST and Novice, Open and Excellent A & B in Preferred FAST.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing. (E-Mail is acceptable) All move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary **no later than 6PM on Monday, August 31, 2009.** Day-to-day move-ups over the weekend will be accepted but must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event (by the end of that days trial).

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

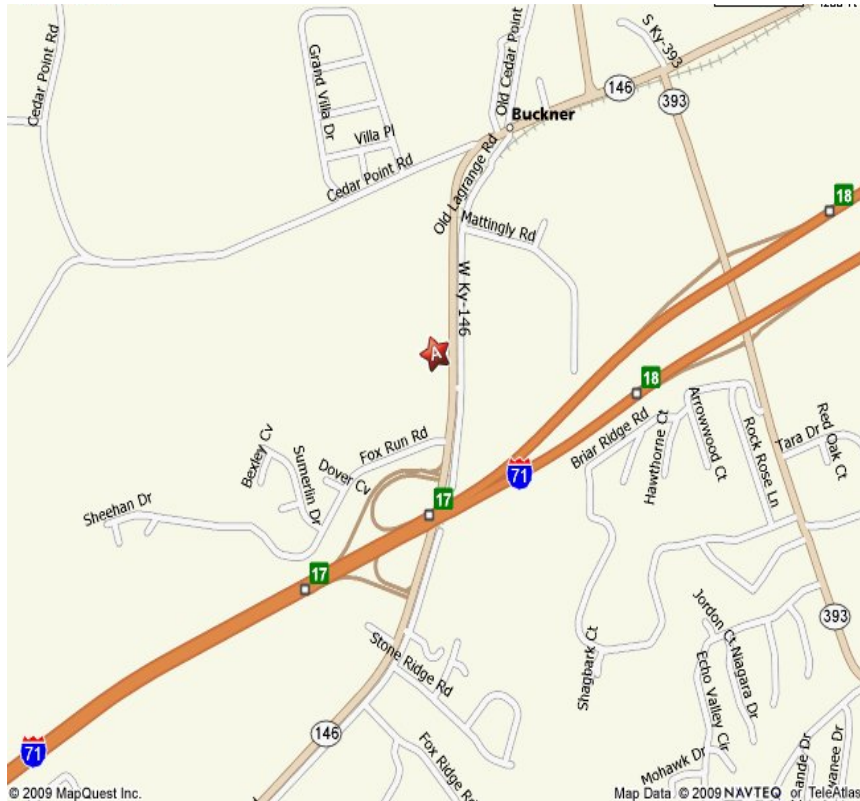

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
