NO ONLINE ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN FOR THIS TRIAL.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES will not be accepted. **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. Unsigned entries or entries missing information other than the dog's call name will be returned. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. **Entry Fees: \$25 first class / \$14 for 2nd class and \$14 for a 3rd class, same dog, same day (includes \$3.50 first run and \$3 each additional run AKC recording fee).** Make checks payable to 'Ochlockonee River Kennel Club of Florida' or 'ORKC'. Checks must be payable in U.S. Funds. **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.** Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible or having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show. **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.** Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made.

ORKC Ribbons and Prizes: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st thru 4th places in all classes except in T2B. In T2B only 1st place will be awarded. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs that receive a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. Upon presentation of a written veterinary certificate there will be partial refund minus \$8.00 per day for bitches in season. All documentation must be received by the trial secretary **no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.**

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

To maximize access to water where possible, the ORKC suggests the use of water T's to permit sharing of spigots. Water T's are not furnished by the club, exhibitors must supply their own. It is recommended that motor homes bring at least 100' of water hose and 100' of heavy duty electrical cord.*** (hookups available for 30 & 50 amps)

*Shower facilities are available.

*There is a Dump Station on the grounds and there are a few sewer hookups.

*Violations or theft of electricity (including piggybacking) or trash/sewage dumping except at designated areas will be subjected to an Event Committee Hearing.

*Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up their parking areas. When leaving the fairgrounds, please leave your trash in closed garbage bags at your parking site.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing.** (E-Mail is acceptable) All move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary **no later than 6PM on Monday, February 19, 2018.** Day-to-day move-ups over the weekend will be accepted but must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event (by the end of that days trial). No moving down or changing or height after closing except as specified in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

Directions: From I-10: Exit at Exit #199 SR 27 (North Monroe Street) and go South until you see the fairgrounds entrance (approximately 9 miles). From Hwy. SR61: Follow the signs for Thomasville Road South and pass under I-10. Continue south on Thomasville Road until it merges into Monroe St. Follow Monroe Street south until you see the entrance to the fairgrounds.

From the east or west: Capital Circle (Hwy. 319) circles Tallahassee. When you reach Capital Circle; go south until you reach SR 61. Go north until you see the fairgrounds entrance.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
